

RE: THE KMAS ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING, NOVEMBER 21, 2001

NOTICE OF MOTION ... Proposed by the KMAS Executive

“Acknowledging the extraordinary effort, investment, and annual dues put out by our KMAS members over the years in creating an R/C flying facility “second-to-none”; and,

Whereas membership growth in KMAS has stalled despite another successful year of operation by the few charter and current members; and,

Whereas young people and new modelers are faced with considerable costs to enter into the hobby/sport of radio control model building and flying; and,

Whereas other club fees, notwithstanding the superior quality of Tolko Field developed by KMAS members, are considerably less than current KMAS fees; and,

Whereas our experience has shown that extra revenues can come from complementary activities such as hamburger nights, pop machine, draws, events, gifts, etc., to meet annual budget needs; therefore,

Be it resolved that KMAS immediately commence an annual operation, subject to review after two years, based on the following:

- 1) the initiation Fee of \$200.00 is waived,**
- 2) the flyer’s Gate Fee is dropped from \$50.00 to \$5.00,**
- 3) the annual Open Member Fee is dropped from \$100.00 to \$60.00,**
- 4) the annual Senior Member Fee is dropped from \$75.00 to \$45.00,**
- 5) the Associate (\$25.00), Spousal (\$25.00), and Junior (\$20.00) Memberships remain,**
- 6) the Lifetime Member status remains as per the Constitution and By-Laws, Article 1,j, (ten times the annual dues).**
- 7) A current MAAC membership is required.”**

For example, through membership years 2002 and 2003, an Open Member’s annual dues would be \$65.00 including a Gate Key. Current MAAC membership is assumed.

The KMAS Constitution and By-Laws remain unchanged.
